

HUG SUMMER 2010 ADVISING WORKSHEET

Students must enroll in, and remain enrolled in, at least 12 credits. Minimum tuition charge is 16 credits.

Students should meet with his/her academic advisor to determine which courses will meet the needs of the student.

- 1. CONSIDER Liberal Arts course needs: HUM 273, HUM 201, and MGRK 100 meet specific liberal arts requirements. These courses will be offered on sufficient demand.**

HUM 273 may be applied to the following courses. Make certain to enroll for the appropriate # of credits to satisfy the intended courses:

ART 101 – 3 credits	HIST 110 or 111 – 3 credits
BIOL 250 – 3 credits	MUS 101 – 3 credits
COMT 101 – 3 credits	PHIL 251 – 3 credits
ENG 201 or 202 – 3 credits	Global Literacy – up to 3 credits

HUM 201 and MGRK 100 may be applied to the global literacy requirement.

Online Biology courses may meet the Biology liberal arts requirement.

- 2. CONSIDER Bible major course needs. Discuss the selection of courses with your academic advisor.**

- 3. SELECT and register for courses:** Note: the registration program will automatically select the lowest number of credits for variable credit courses. You will need to manually increase the number of credits.
