

# Harding University in Australia

## Cost for Fall 2010

---

**Four payments** must be paid to Harding University before you can attend HUA. The payments and due dates are listed below for the fall semester. Explanation of fee and payments follow.

<b>PAYMENT</b>	<b>for FALL semester</b>
<b>\$ 400</b>	with application
<b>\$ 2,380</b>	May 15
<b>\$ 2,200</b>	June 15
<b>\$14,100</b>	July 5

- **APPLICATION FEE (\$400)** – paid at the time of application. **This fee is non-refundable** if you drop out of the program.
- **TRAVEL PAYMENTS (\$2,380 & \$2,200)** – include round-trip airfare from Little Rock to Australia, all school-sponsored field trips (an Asian country, New Zealand, Outback tour, seven-day cruise, etc.), and International Student ID. **PLEASE NOTE: No frequent flyer tickets may be used for the flight. All arrangements are made by the International Programs office.** Frequent flyer miles may be accumulated. *A fuel surcharge, imposed by the airlines, may be added. Typically, fuel surcharges range from \$100-\$400. The fee will not exceed \$500.*
- **FINAL PAYMENT (\$14,100)** – includes entrance fees for museums and art galleries, tour guides, local travel, facility cleaning, linen/laundry, tuition for 16 hours, room and board, program fee and technology fee. Most financial aid that you have on the Searcy campus will apply to your semester abroad.
- **DON'T FORGET SPENDING MONEY!** - You will need to provide your own spending money and **we recommend that you allow up to \$60-70 per day for all independent travel on weekends or at the end of the term.**
