

Harding University in England

Cost for Fall 2010

Four payments must be paid to Harding University before you can attend HUE. The payments and due dates are listed below for the semester that you will be attending HUE. Explanation of fee and payments follow.

- **APPLICATION FEE (\$400)** – paid at the time of application. **This fee is non-refundable** if you drop out of the program.
- **TRAVEL PAYMENTS (\$2,200 & \$2,100)** – include round-trip airfare from Little Rock to Dublin (with a possible return from other cities, if desired), a three months' ticket for the London Subway, seven field trips in England (visits to Oxford, Cambridge, Stonehenge, Bath, Canterbury, Stratford-on-Avon and many more places), a one-week field trip to Scotland, Ireland and Wales, a special event fund to attend concerts, operas (such as Phantom of the Opera) and plays, and an International Student ID. **PLEASE NOTE: No frequent flyer tickets may be used for the flight. All arrangements are made by the International Programs office.** Frequent flyer miles may be accumulated. *A fuel surcharge, imposed by the airlines, may be added. Typically, fuel surcharges range from \$100-\$400. The fee will not exceed \$500.*
- **FINAL PAYMENT (\$13,890)** – includes entrance fees for museums and art galleries, tour guides, local travel, facility cleaning, linen/laundry, tuition for 16 hours, room and board, program fee and technology fee. Most financial aid that you have on the Searcy campus will apply to your semester abroad.
- **DON'T FORGET SPENDING MONEY!** - You will need to provide your own spending money and **we recommend that you allow up to \$80-85 per day for all independent travel.** You will have the option of returning to the USA from other cities so that you can do independent travel on the continent at the end of the semester at your expense.
