

# Harding University in Greece

## Cost for 2010-2011 School Year

**Four payments** must be paid to Harding University before you can attend HUG. The payments and due dates are listed below according to the semester that you will be attending HUG. Explanation of fee and payments follow.

- **APPLICATION FEE (\$400)** – paid at the time of application. **This fee is non-refundable** if you drop out of the program.
- **TRAVEL PAYMENTS (\$2,390 & \$2,190)** – include round-trip airfare from Little Rock to Athens, an International Student ID, and the following educational tours: a cruise to the Greek Islands, Egypt, Israel, Northern Greece, Corinth, Mycenae, Epidaurus and Delphi. **For students who wish to tour Western Europe after the semester is over, you may make arrangements with Mr. Bill Spear to purchase a Eurail Pass. PLEASE NOTE: No frequent flyer tickets may be used for the flight. All arrangements are made by the International Programs office.** Frequent flyer miles may be accumulated. *A fuel surcharge, imposed by the airlines, may be added. Typically, fuel surcharges range from \$100-\$400. The fee will not exceed \$500.*
- **FINAL PAYMENT (\$13,960)** – includes entrance fees for museums and art galleries, tour guides, local travel, facility cleaning, linen/laundry, book rental, tuition for 16 hours, room and board, program fee and technology fee. Most financial aid that you have on the Searcy campus will apply to your semester abroad.
- **DON'T FORGET SPENDING MONEY!** - You will need to provide your own spending money and **we recommend that you allow up to 50 Euros (\$75-80) per day for all independent travel.** You will have approximately 15 days of optional independent travel at the conclusion of the semester.

- *Those who cancel after airline tickets have been purchased and land travel arrangements have been paid will be liable for any penalties assessed by the airlines and land travel companies. Funds that can be recovered will be returned to the student's account as soon as possible.*
- *If you are enrolling in a future semester not indicated on this cost sheet, you may estimate the payment cost increase at 4-5% per school year.*
